LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

May 2021

I HOPE EVERYONE IS WELL AND STAYING SAFE!

JUST TO GET EVERYONE UP TO DATE THE PAINTERS HAVE STARTED ON THE SOUTH SIDE, THEY ARE PROCEEDING QUITE WELL. THE NORTH SIDE SHOULD BE GETTING STARTED POSSIBLY EARLY JUNE. THEY WILL BE ATTACHING A NOTICE WITH THE APPROXIMATE TIME OF WHEN THEY ARE TO START YOUR HOUSE. A PRICE LIST WILL ALSO BE ATTACHED WITH ITEMS YOU MAY WISH TO HAVE DONE AS WELL.

IF YOU HAVE A REQUEST SUCH AS (DON'T PAINT MY GARAGE DOOR) FOR AN EXAMPLE, YOU CAN MAKE NOTE AT THAT TIME. **ANY ACCENT COLORS WILL NEED TO BE APPROVED BY THE ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE BEFORE PAINTING BEGINS.** THE FORMS ARE SELF EXPLANATORY. THE PAINTER WILL SUBMIT THE ARCHITECTURAL REQUEST FORM TO THE COMMITTEE FOR YOU.

SO FAR THE QUALITY OF THE WORK HAS BEEN VERY GOOD. WE HAVE A COUPLE OF PEOPLE INSPECTING THE WORK WITH THE FOREMAN TO MAKE SURE THE JOB IS DONE CORRECTLY AND COMPLETED.

JUST TO REMIND EVERYONE THAT THE BUSHES AND TREES THAT ARE UP AGAINST YOUR HOUSE MUST BE TRIMMED BACK AT LEAST 1 FOOT TO GIVE PAINTERS ACCESS TO PAINT. IF IT IS NOT POSSIBLE FOR THEM TO PAINT THAT AREA THEY WILL SKIP AROUND IT.

ANY ITEMS LEANING AGAINST THE HOUSE MUST ALSO BE MOVED, INCLUDING LARGE FLOWER POTS. **REMEMBER TO DISCONNECT YOUR HOSES.**

MAKE SURE YOUR CAR AND ANY PATIO FURNITURE IS **MOVED OUT OF THE WAY** TO PREVENT ANY OVER SPRAY OF PAINT.

The painters will be pressure washing everything, such as awnings, walls, and decorative walls even if it is painted a different color. Anything that is now white will be painted white, **colors will not be painted unless you have requested it.** Awnings will not be painted at all unless requested by the owner. We are trying to get some color in the community, but we are trying to keep the colors soft - that is why the approval is necessary. I hope all residents will appreciate this.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

You have made a personal decision to live in a community that is a registered association. Associations are governed by a set of rules. The rules are for all residents ---- NO EXCEPTIONS.

PARKING

There are no defined parking spaces on community streets. Spaces cannot be saved. Our streets are maintained by the City of Margate and you can park anywhere as long as you:

- Park on the correct side of the street, which is THE SIDE OPPOSITE of the NO PARKING signs and in the direction of the traffic flow.
- When parking in the street, please DO NOT park in the middle of the front yard. This takes up two possible parking spaces. Any questions or complaints must go through the Management Company listed on the front page.
- DO NOT BLOCK ANYONE'S DRIVEWAY.

POOL RULES AND HOURS

- The pool is open from 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM
- Please use your key when using the pool. Keys may be obtained with a deposit by contacting Paul at dsbuildinginc@att.net or at meetings when they resume.
- **Please be considerate to the number of guests you entertain at the pool. HOMEOWNERS MUST ACCOMPANY GUESTS IN THE POOL AREA,** Particularly residents with visiting children.
- Food and beverages will be allowed in designated areas (at tables). All liquids must be in plastic containers and you must clean up the area when finished.
- There will still be NO ALCOHOL allowed.

ATTENTION DOG OWNERS!

- All dogs must be leashed and restrained at all times.
- Do not walk your dog on anyone else's property.
- You must clean up after your dog!

PERSONAL YARD AND GARAGE SALES

Our by-laws prohibit all yard and/or garage sales.

BE MINDFUL OF YOUR NEIGHBORS

We live in a neighborhood with the homes in close proximity to each other. It is extremely important - **and the homeowner's responsibility** - to keep trees and shrubs trimmed. Not only does it make our community look more attractive, it can eliminate hard feelings between neighbors if your tree should damage your neighbor's property. Keeping your bushes trimmed eliminates places for iguanas to hide. **Iguanas carry salmonella and botulism.** If you are unable to maintain your trees and shrubs yourself, you may call the lawn service company and they can help with it FOR A FEE. (free estimates)

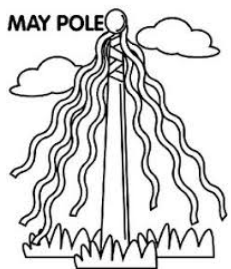

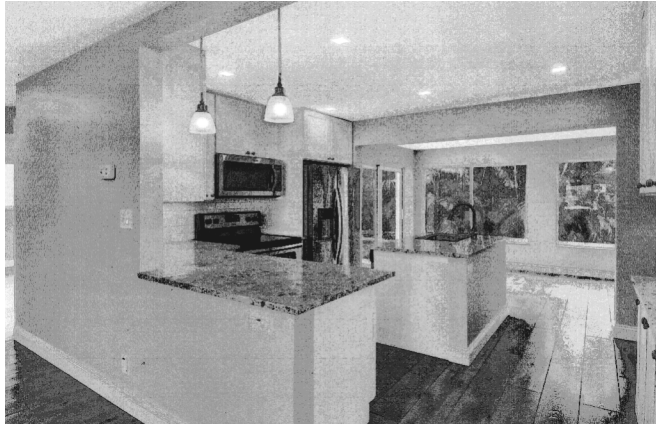

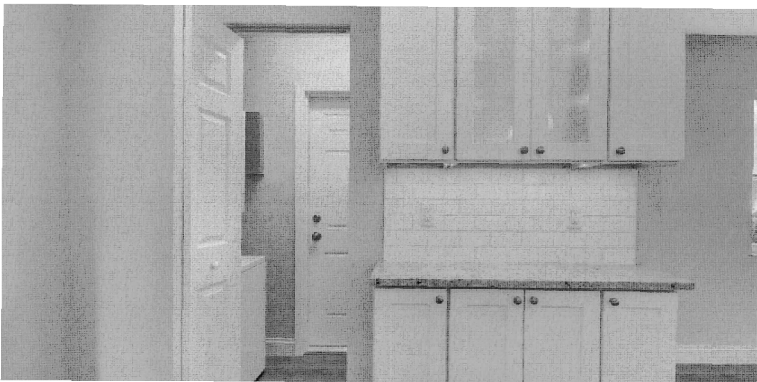
